Beetle Caresheet Checklist



- Enclosures should be at least 2x the length of beetle in all 3 dimensions
- Beetles can fly, a lid can prevent escapes but allow ventilation with small holes
- 3 Substrate choices: sawdust, wood shavings, tissue, coir
- **(**Optional) Sphagnum moss helps to maintain humidity
- 6 Add grip wood or twigs for beetle to reorientate if flipped over
- Beetles are solitary, males should be kept separate
- Females can be introduced for mating but will shorten the male's lifespan.
- **3** Adult beetles consume tree sap, nectar and fruits such as apples and bananas. Reptile fruit jellies are convenient alternatives, Feed every 3-5 days.
- Avoid feeding citrus fruits such as orange/lemon
- Avoid direct sunlight causing dryness and overheating.
- Beetles excrete in liquid, renew substrate regularly or when conditions degrade.
